
South West Japan Festival

The website for Origins, stated that closing was at 6pm on Sunday (13/8/23). We arrived just before 5 pm allowing 1 hour to look around and purchase anything. We wanted to buy some Gin/Vodka from Old Youngs and look at the coffee etc. However a stall holder advised us that it was late and therefore a lot of the stands were closing or closed! This was extremely disappointing. We did have a wonder round but they were correct in that there were only a handful open. One offered to reopen if we wanted to purchase anything, but another said quite clearly that she was closed. It was 5pm and closing was not till 6 pm. Extremely disappointing" August 2023.

Fire Alarms

Recently we have experienced two fire alarms near the food truck area. The fire brigade has suggested we replace the smoke sensor with a heat sensor. This was no fault of any vendor in the area and the problem is exacerbated in winter because the louvres are usually closed and the reason they are there is to dissipate the smoke. Vass will oversee the replacement and we apologise for any inconvenience .
