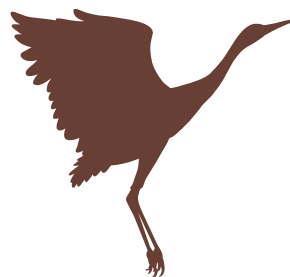

EDUCATION OFFICER

Origins Market provides a tour guide for all school groups and education visits with a current Working with Children check.

SUPERVISION

Adequate supervision and appropriate adult to child ratios are required throughout your visit to Origins Market. Student supervision is the responsibility of the school and the supervisory team must accompany students throughout the excursion, actively monitor behaviour and intervene as necessary.

PARKING

There is plenty of parking at Origins Market. Small tour groups and shuttle bus drop off at the front of the building in the designated small bus area. Large coaches must drop off at the rear of the building in the loading dock area. In the event of inclement weather, groups may be dropped at the first loading dock which is undercover.
