We'll discuss the 6 seasons and how they differ to the four that we live by, as well as what they mean to Aboriginal people.

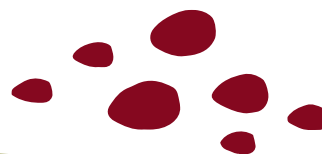
BUSY BEES

THE 6 INDIGENOUS SEASONS

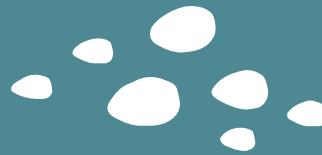
Activities:

EDUCATION OFFICER

Origins Market provides a tour guide for all school groups and education visits with a current Working with Children check.

SUPERVISION

Adequate supervision and appropriate adult to child ratios are required throughout your visit to Origins Market. Student supervision is the responsibility of the school and the supervisory team must accompany students throughout the excursion, actively monitor behaviour and intervene as necessary. The lead teacher will need to provide a mobile phone number with their booking or on arrival at the markets.

TRANSPORT

There is plenty of parking located at Origins Market. Small tour groups and shuttle bus drop off at the front of the building in the designed small bus area. Large coaches must drop off at the rear of the building in the loading dock area. In the event of inclement weather, groups may be dropped at the first loading dock which is undercover. Please call ahead on 0457 452 216 to make arrangements.

FOOD AND DRINK

Morning/afternoon tea and lunch can be arranged upon request. Please enquire for our pricing. Students are permitted to bring their own lunch if required.

THE DAY OF YOUR TOUR

Tours are conducted Thursday to Sunday only. Once a booking is made you'll receive an event order that you'll need to sign and return at least 2 weeks before your tour. Final numbers will need to be submitted to events@originsmarket.com.au no later than 4 days before your tour. Upon arrival on the day of your tour, report to the Information Bay (stall 4). Please give the Education Officer the number of students and adults in attendance and a mobile phone number of an accompanying teacher.
